


# Phillips Scout Camp

3511 Camp Phillips Road, Weston WI 54476

Phillips Scout Camp is located along the Eau Claire River in Weston, WI. The camp is named after Henry J. Phillips, a businessman and philanthropist from Wausau. The camp is available to all Scouting units and other youth organizations for day activities, short-term camping, and training.

## FEATURES:

- McCormick Lodge is a small meeting hall with an equipped kitchen (electric range, refrigerator, and microwave). The lodge is heated, has a restroom, running water, and is handicapped accessible.
- Group campsites available; sites A, B and C have a picnic shelter with tables. Campsite D is located across the bridge on the island. Campfire rings near all sites.
- There are four cabins at Camp Phillips: Rotary, Elks, Horgan and Evans. Each cabin offers 5 bunks (sleeps 10), a table and benches, lighting, and heat.
- Outdoor shelter with charcoal grill, picnic tables, and electric.
- WiFi available in the lodge and surrounding area.
- A sports field for soccer and other games, horseshoe pit, and GaGa ball pit all available.

## DIRECTIONS:

To get to Phillips Scout Camp: From Hwy 51, take Hwy 29 east toward Green Bay. Exit at Camp Phillips Road. Go north on Camp Phillips Road, through the third stop light. Phillips Scout Camp is about a half mile past the third stop light at Ross Avenue, on the right hand side.
