## Leave No Trace Tread Lightly





This Course is designed for Boy Scout Leaders and Scouts 14 and older who value the land and want to teach others how to protect and preserve it. It will meet the requirements (exception for number camping night practicing LNT) for scouts looking to fill the Venturing or Boy Scout Leave No Trace/Tread Lightly Award. Graduates will receive a Leave No Trace diploma and will be qualified to teach Leave No Trace skills and ethics to all levels of Scouting.

This is a 16 hour overnight training and you will be certified by the Leave No Trace Center for Outdoor Ethics as a Leave No Trace Trainer and will meet the requirements for Scouts who have been appointed as the Troop Leave No Trace/Tread Lightly Trainer.

There are many ways to teach Leave No Trace. You will be encouraged to follow thru and complete a Master Educators Course but there is a need for qualified Scouters to teach awareness workshops at the Cub Scout, Boy Scout and Venturing levels. Trainers are needed to prepare units for high adventure trips for hiking, biking and canoeing. Leave No Trace workshops can be added to Council and District events and trainers will be needed to present them.
