In an effort to help build awareness for adult leader and parents about some of the basic youth protection principles, the Youth Protection Committee has updated our YP web page to give you easy access to the resources you will need. Located at: <https://www.samoset.org/youth-protection>

Adult Training is REQUIRED for all volunteers - Go to my.scouting.org. Click on "Create an Account" **if** you do not already have one. Enter "log-in" information. Now you can access Adult Youth Protection Training on the right-hand side of the page. When complete, print the certificate and keep one copy for your reference.

Cub Scout Leaders – check out the "Protect Yourself Rules". These videos are Den/age appropriate. Please incorporate these into your den meetings this fall and submit the training record by 12/31/22.

Scouts BSA, Venturing, Sea Scout Leaders - check out the "Personal Safety Awareness" training videos We are asking that all units hold YP training sometime this fall. We are also asking that you document all who were in attendance and submit the roster to council (at the latest, with your charter renewal) by 12/31/22.

All Scouts BSA youth are supposed to go through some form of Youth Protection training each year, usually they are in the form of Cyber Chip videos or other online videos such as those listed below:
