Boy Scout Religious Emblems

An application (found in the front of your workbook) to begin working on the Ad Altare Dei and the Pope Pius XII must be filled out completely prior to beginning work on the emblem. Upon completion of the workbook, schedule a Board of Review with a CCS approved board, have the back of the application signed by all parties prior to the BOR and send along with a \$15.00 payment (made out to The Catholic Committee on Scouting) to the Religious Emblems Chairman. Please include the Scoutmasters and the facilitators name, address, and phone number on the form near their signatures. I would suggest to also making a copy in case it gets lost along the way.

The Emblem will be presented at an annual Recognition Ceremony, in the spring, notification will be sent when the dates have been set.

The embroidered knot will be sent to the Scoutmaster, (if any Religious Emblems have been earned previously then an appropriate device would be sent) and should be presented at a Court of Honor or special ceremony.

Designed for 6-7 years old Cub Scouts

Parvuli Dei

Designed for 8-10 years old Cub Scouts.

Ad Altare Dei

Designed for any youth of the Roman Catholic Faith who is registered in a BSA Troop or Crew..

Pope Pius XII

Designed for Venturing Crew Members and Boy Scouts 15 years old and older.

<u>Light is Life</u> Designed for Boy Scouts, 12 -13 years old of the Eastern-rite Catholic Churches. Scouts in the Eastern Catholic Churches work on Light is Life rather than the Ad Altare Dei emblem.
