## Need to Know

### What to Bring

Just like any other event the unit is responsible for gathering medical forms and making sure all the necessary information is on the forms. While checking in our staff will request to hold onto your forms while at the Camporee and ask each participant how they are feeling. All participants not feeling well are asked to stay home. Here's a list of common items you and your unit should have:

Tentage appropriate for all ages and sexes

Cooking gear for the weekend

Appropriate gear for October weather.

### Camping Areas

We will be using the campsites on the Hanna side of the property closest to the East Shower building so all units will have access to hot showers throughout the weekend. Our staff will be assigning campsites based off registration numbers and what type of units are in camp (female and male units, etc)

### Vehicles in Camp

Vehicles will be allowed at the campsite if they do not block pathways and roads. Driving of vehicles during the event is prohibited.

### Firewood

It's our Council policy that bringing in outside firewood is prohibited. Firewood is available for purchase or units can gather downed wood from around camp.

### Meals

Meals are provided by each respective unit. But the unit may choose to purchase a camp lunch on Saturday for \$6.00 per person, payable at the camporee.

### Water

Potable water is available at the East Shower house for water bottles and campsite use. Water will not be turned on at the campsites due to freezing weather.

### Prohibited Items

As like in any other camping event the use of drugs and alcohol is strictly prohibited. Smoking is only allowed by adults at maintenance and not near scouts. Also not allowed is any type of weapons.

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## Event Fees

- Pre-registration is \$15.00 for each attendee.
- The fee covers the patch, fees, insurance, and awards.
- Pre-registration is open until Tuesday October 5th.
- After October 5th. There is a \$5.00 per person fee added, to include date of registrations.
