#### **Social Media**

Sharing your Scout unit's upcoming joining events and showing the fun you're having as a troop helps potential Scouts to gain excitement about participating.

Helpful tips for social media promotion:

- Use a photo or insert a link to the Samoset Council website in the post. Photos and links help capture attention better than using only text. Unit leaders can create a free account with the BSA Brand Center to download Scouting images and marketing resources. (www.Scoutingwire.org/bsa-brand-center)
- Post regularly about your troop's activities and encourage new people to check out your joining events. Families may be thinking about joining Scouting, but haven't signed up yet. It may take several touchpoints with Scouting for someone to make the leap into registration.
- Consider starting a Private Facebook Group for your Scouting unit if you would like to separate troop-related news and photos from your personal page. Extend invitations to current members and invite interested families to join your group.

Sample messages for promoting Scouts (Feel free to use as is or personalize):

### Additional ways to promote Scouts around town

- Put up flyers at libraries, churches, pools, Boys and Girls Clubs
- Stuff grocery bags with a flyer
- Place posters inside grocery stores and pharmacies

- Create a Nextdoor.com post, or post in a Neighborhood Facebook Group
- Hand out flyers when selling popcorn
- Place yard signs in high traffic areas with a lower speed limit
